City chooses its final four for Collindale pro position

We had 10 good proposals," said O'Neill, the city's director of purchasing and risk management and one of the search committee's six members, said Tuesday. "These four ranked highest of the rest of them. There was a natural break between the top four and the rest."

Candidates not making the cut include Dan Bruntz, a SouthRidge assistant pro; Dave Heinly of Greeley; Glenn; Bill Martin, an as-

stant pro at Patty Jewett GC in Colorado Springs; Bob McNamee, an assistant at Highland Hills GC in Greeley; Brett Barcel of Bloomingtondale, Ill.; and Daniel Flynn of Lodi, N.J. Flynn was a finalist last year at City Park Nine.

"That's the major piece (of the selection process)," O'Neill said. "We will rate the candidates on the same criteria that we had from the proposals."
