Description of Bid #5795 North College Avenue and Jefferson/Riverside Avenue Improvements

OPENING DATE:

Delete subsection 109.06(a)

NOTE: The Retainage Amount is specified in the Agreement, Sections 5.1.1 & 5.1.2.

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“Liquidated Damages”

Delete the revision to subsection 108.07.

NOTE: The Incentive amounts and Liquidated Damage amounts are specified in the Agreement, Section 3.2.

ITEM 3: Revision of Section 620 – Standard Special Provisions
“Field Laboratories with Forced Air Convection Oven”

Delete Revision of Section 620 – Standard Special Provisions.

NOTE: Section 620 is revised in the Project Special Provisions. Please refer to this specification for bid item 620-00005 – Field Office (Special).

ITEM 4: Revision of Section 630 – Project Special Provisions
“Mobile Pavement Marking Zone”

Delete item 630-80510 from the Bid Tab. Please fill in the “Unit Price” & “Price” columns with “0”.

ITEM 5: Revision of Section 108 – Project Special Provisions
“Prosecution and Progress”

Subsection 108.04 shall include the following:

The Mulberry and Riverside Intersection and the Riverside/Jefferson mill and overlay portions of the project must be Substantially Complete by November 7, 2003.

ITEM 6: Project Special Provisions
“Traffic Control Plan – General”

Delete Section C, Page 82. Replace with the following:

C. During all phases of construction a minimum of two lanes in each direction shall remain open on North College. One exception shall be when working at the BNSF railroad north of Cherry. One lane operation will be allowed but shall be limited to duration of no longer than 7 days in any 30 day period. Other exceptions may be allowed for short durations with prior approval from the Owner. For the Jefferson/Riverside mill and inlay, a maximum of one lane shall be closed at any one time.

ITEM 7: Revision of Section 630 – Project Special Provisions
“Channelizing Device (Special)”

Add the following specification:

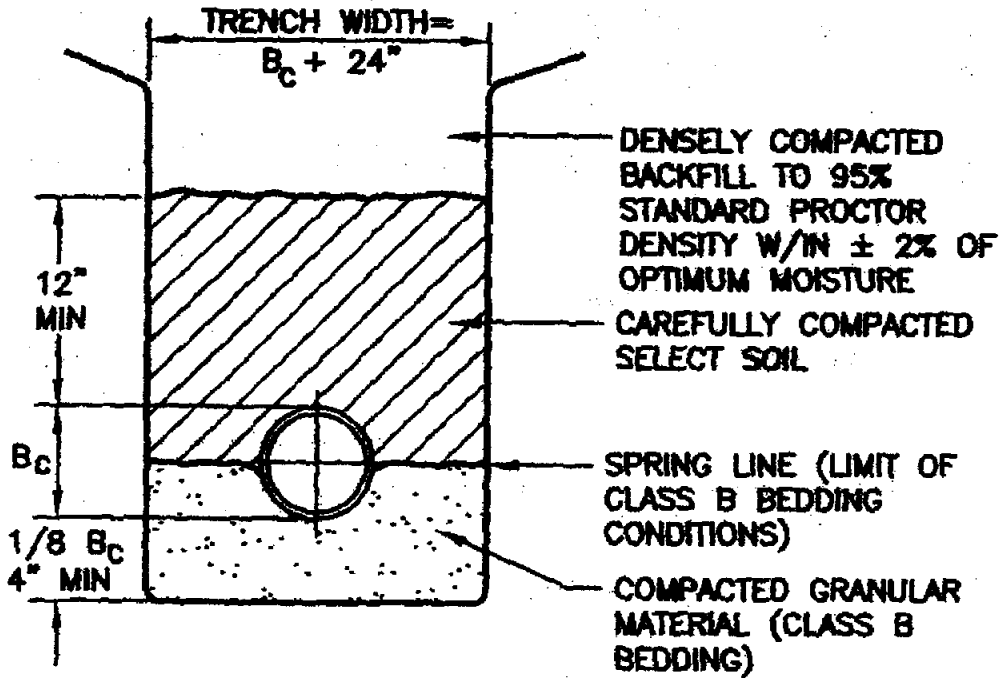

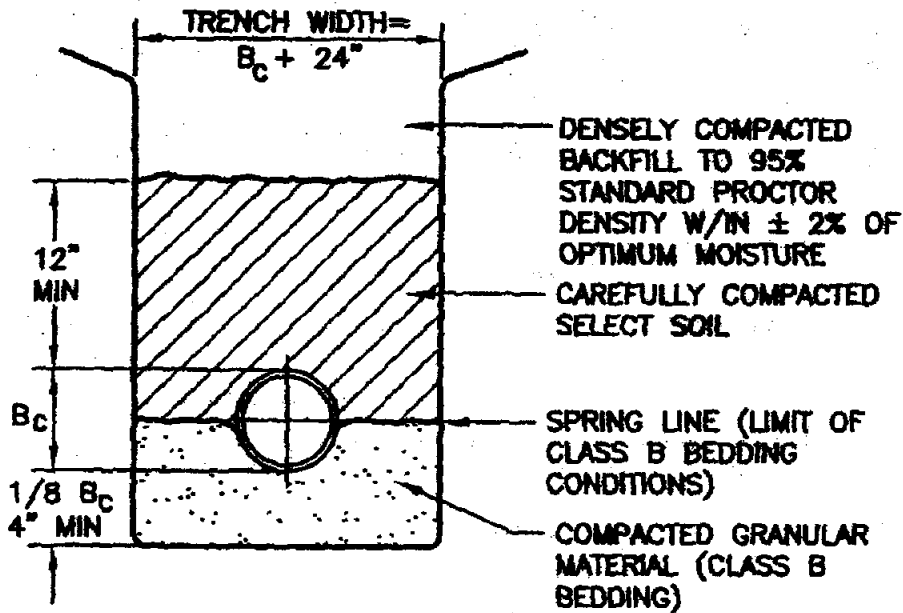
