

ORDINANCE NO. 1 1960  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 28, 1959, (SECTION 9-1 et seq. FORT  
COLLINS CODE, 1958) COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE FIRE PREVENTION  
CODE, ESTABLISHING ANNUAL LICENSE FEES FOR FILLING STATIONS,  
TANKS, PUMPS AND TANK VEHICLES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS:

Section 1. That Section 6A of Ordinance No. 28, 1958, (Section 9-6, Fort Collins Code, 1958) be and the same is hereby amended and changed in the following respects:

A. Article 15 is amended and changed by adding thereto Section 15.107 as follows:

"Section 15.107. Fees for permits and occupation tax.

The following fees for permits shall be charged and collected under this ordinance. For each tank installed, Five Dollars (\$5.00); for each pump installed; Five Dollars (\$5.00).

The operator of each filling station shall obtain an annual permit for each pump used in the operation of such filling station and shall pay for each of said permits an annual license fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The owner of each installed private pump shall obtain an annual permit for the same and shall pay therefor an annual license fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00).


B. Article 15 is amended and changed so that 15.902 shall read as follows:

"Section 15.902. Permit required and license fee therefor.

No person shall engage in the business of delivering flammable liquids from tank vehicles without a permit. Such permit shall be obtained from the City Clerk of the City of Fort Collins. Each application for such a permit shall be accompanied by the sum of Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for the first tank vehicle and Seven and 50/100 Dollars (\$7.50) for each additional tank vehicle owned and used by the applicant which said sums shall be in payment of the annual license fee for said permit.

Introduced, considered favorably on first reading and ordered published this 11th day of February, 1960, to be considered for final passage on the 10th day of March, 1960.
