

ORDINANCE NO 1 1945
BEING AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE VACATION OF PORTIONS OF WILLOW STREET AND LINCOLN AVENUE IN THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS

Section 1 That all that portion of Willow Street in the City of Fort Collins described as follows, to-wit

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Block 15 in the City of Fort Collins, thence N 49° 00' W 320 feet along the Southwest side of Block 15, thence S 41° 00' W 32 feet, thence S 49° 00' E 129 feet, thence S 58° 40' E 193 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0 165 acres, more or less,

be and the same is hereby vacated and the title thereto shall vest in the abutting property owner

Section 2 That all that portion of Lincoln Avenue in the City of Fort Collins described as follows, to-wit

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Block 15 in the City of Fort Collins, thence N 88° 35' E 78 feet, thence N 18° 15' E 72 feet, thence N 71° 20' W 32 feet, thence S 41° 00' W 107 feet along the Southeast side of Block 15 to the point of beginning, containing 0 097 acres, more or less,

be and the same is hereby vacated and the title thereto shall vest in the abutting property owner

Section 3 In the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage under and by virtue of the authority contained in Sections 6 and 7 of Article IV of the City Charter
