

ORDINANCE NO. 5

SERIES OF 1909.

RELATING TO THE DISTRIBUTION OF WATER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, COLORADO:


Section 1. All water consumers within the city of Fort Collins shall be divided into two classes, the first, those occupying premises with street numbers odd numbered, and the second class, those with even numbered street numbers.

Section 2. That between the first day of May and the first day of November of each year, water may be taken for irrigation and sprinkling by all water users who have paid their water rent and obtained their receipt therefor, at the following times only: Water consumers of the first class on the first day of ~~each month~~ ^{Every} ~~month~~ ^{Each month} and each alternate day thereafter, Water consumers of the second class on the second day of ~~the~~ ^{Each} month and each alternate day thereafter.


Section 3. Any person who shall use or permit to be used any water for irrigation or sprinkling, for for any other purpose than domestic uses at any time between the first day of May and the first day of November of each year, except as permitted by the terms of Section 2 hereof, shall upon conviction be fined in the sum of not less than three dollars, nor more than twenty dollars and costs.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 7 of 1902, ~~and all other ordinances in relation to use of water~~, passed and adopted May 19, 1902, is hereby repealed.
