

ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF THE SERIES OF 1909.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY CLERK, WATER SUPERINTENDENT, STREET SUPERVISOR, CITY TREASURER AND CITY HEALTH OFFICER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, COLORADO:

Section 1. That commencing with the terms of office of the officials hereinafter named and shall be elected in April, 1909, they shall receive salaries as follows:

The City Clerk shall receive a salary of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per month.

The Water Superintendent shall receive a salary of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75) per month.

The Street Supervisor shall receive a salary of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month.

The City Treasurer shall receive a salary of Sixteen and two-thirds Dollars (\$16-2/3) per month.

And the City Health Officer shall receive a salary of Forty Dollars (\$40) per month.


Section 2. All officers of the City not mentioned above shall receive such compensation as now provided by ordinance, and all employees of the City not hereinabove mentioned shall receive such compensation as the City Council may from time to time direct. The salaries herein provided for shall be subject to the deductions provided for in Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2 of 1905 ^{for} failure to attend meetings of the Council.
