

Ordinance No. 14, Series of 1910.  
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DOMESTIC FOWLS RUNNING AT LARGE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to cause or permit any chicken or chickens or other domestic fowls to run at large within the limits of the city of Fort Collins.

Sec. 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in the sum of not less than five dollars, nor more than fifty dollars for each offense.

Sec. 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
