


ORDINANCE NO. 14 OF THE SERIES OF ~~1909~~ ¹⁹⁰⁸.

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE PROVISIONS OF THE FOLLOWING NAMED ORDINANCES REQUIRING THE PAYMENT OF LICENSE FEES, TO-WIT:
ORDINANCE NO. 15 entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to Food and the Inspection Thereof", passed and adopted July 22, 1907; and also Ordinance No. 3, Series of 1908, entitled "An Ordinance to Amend Section One of Article 2 and Section 1 of Article 3, and Section 1 of Article 5; ~~of~~ Ordinance No. 15 of the Series of 1907, entitled "An Ordinance in Relation to Food and the Inspection thereof", passed and adopted April 20, 1908.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS,
COLORADO:


Section 1. That hereafter no license fee shall be exacted or required from dealers in milk or cream or dealers in meat, ice and food products, and the several provisions requiring the payment of such license fees in Ordinance No. 15 of 1907 and Ordinance No. 3 of 1908 are hereby repealed, provided, however that the dealers in such articles within the City of Fort Collins shall nevertheless apply for permit, as provided thereunder in each case.
