

PROPOSED ORDINANCE.

Public notice is hereby given that the following ordinance was introduced, read and ordered printed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Fort Collins, Colo., held January 19th, 1903.

Ordinance No. 1., 1903

Relating to Sewers:

A petition having been presented to the City Council for the construction of a sewer, commencing at the main sewer on locust street, at a point where the center of alley line of Block 129 would intersect said sewer, thence south in the center of alley in blocks 129, and block 6 in Lake Park, a distance of 700 feet including the streets, and signed by a majority of the property owners abutting on said proposed sewer, therefore:

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins, Colo., Section 1. That a sewer be constructed by laying a sewer pipe line, commencing at the main sewer on Locust Street, at a point where the alley line of block 129 would intersect with said main sewer, thence south and along the center of alleys in blocks 129, and block 6 in Lake Park, a distance of 700 feet, said sewer pipe to be eight inches in diameter, manholes and tees to be placed along said sewer at such points as the Committee having same in charge shall deem necessary.

Section 2. That said sewer shall be known as Sewer District No. 15.

Section 3. That the cost of construction of said sewer extension at and upon the street intersections and the amount which shall have been assessed to the public general shall be paid for by the City with warrants drawn upon the general fund appropriation.

Section 4. The cost of said sewer extension and the expense incident thereto shall be assessed, except as provided in section three hereof, pro-rata against the lots and blocks abutting and opposite to said sewer in proportion to the frontage of said lots and blocks abutting upon said sewer extension according to and under the provisions of ordinance No. 12 1890, relating to sewers and drains, passed and adopted February 16, 1891; and as amended by ordinance No. 1, 1893, passed and adopted March 20, 1893, and ordinance No. 19, 1884 relating to the assessment and collection of assessments and special charges, passed and adopted September 15, 1884; Provided, that the amount of such assessment shall be paid in the first instance by warrants drawn upon a fund which is hereby created to be known and designated as Sewer District No. 15 fund; and all money derived and collected from the assessments hereinbefore provided for shall be applied to the maintenance of said Sewer District No. 15 fund, and to the redemption of the warrants drawn upon said fund, and for no other purpose what soever.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced, read and ordered printed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Fort Collins, Colorado, held on the 19th day of January A.D. 1903, and was published in the Fort Collins Argus on the 21st day of January A.D. 1903, and was duly passed and adopted by the said City Council at the regular meeting held on the 16th day of February A.D., 1903.
