

Ordinance No 7 1899

Relating to herding of & driving of
cattle through the Streets of the City

Be it Ordained by the City Council
of the City of Fort Collins

Sec - 1 - It shall be unlawful for
any person or persons while
driving or causing to be driven,
any Milch Cows or other live
Stock, through the Streets or Alleys
of the City of Fort Collins to leave
said ^{milch} Cows or other live Stock unat-
tended so that said Milch Cows
or other live Stock may go upon
any lawn or lawns park or yards
along the Side or Sides of any Street
or Streets in said City; or to go upon
the lawn or lawns, garden or gar-
dens or premises of any person
or persons within ^{the limits of} said City of
Fort Collins

Sec - 2 - Any person who shall
violate ^{any of} the provisions of Section
one of this Ordinance shall be
guilty of a misdemeanor & upon
conviction thereof before the Po-
lice Magistrate shall be fined in
the sum of not less than five
dollars nor more than one hundred

dollars

Sec-3 - Any person or persons fined under the provisions of this Ordinance who shall not pay such fine and the costs assessed shall be confined in the City Jail or County Jail or place of confinement for prisoners one day for each two dollars of such fine & costs or such person may be required to work on the Streets or Public's grounds of the City of Fort Collins one day for each two dollars of such fine & costs, until the same is fully paid

Sec-4 - All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed
