

Ordinance No 4 1894

A Petition having been presented to the City Council for the Construction of a Stone Sidewalk on the South Side of Oak Street between Remington & Sherwood Streets and Ripper by a portion of the owners of frontage upon said street between the points above named

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins

Sec. 1 That a stone sidewalk shall be constructed on Oak Street as follows: commencing at the North East corner of block No. 122 thence running west & in front of the blocks on the South side of Dairy ^{only} Street to the Northeast corner of block 72. Said sidewalk to be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same at their own expense within thirty days from the time at which this Ordinance shall take effect. And thereby be relieved from any assessments

that may be made for the construction thereof by the City, ~~provided~~ provided that the work to be done, shall in all respects conform to the requirements of the Ordinance relating to Sidewalks passed & adopted November 14th A.D. 1884

Sec. 2 - That if the Sidewalk mentioned in Section one of this Ordinance shall not be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same within the time mentioned in said Section one then such Sidewalk shall be constructed by the City, under & in pursuance of the provisions of Ordinance No. 19, 1884 concerning the assessment of Special Charges upon the owners of lots or lands within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Collins.
