

— Ordinance No 2-1896 —

Relating to Sidewalks on Howes Street

Whereas a petition having been presented to the City Council for the construction of a stone sidewalk on the west side of Howes Street between Myrtle and Laurel Streets, and signed by the majority of the owners of frontage upon said street therefore — Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins,

— Section I — That a stone sidewalk shall be constructed on Howes Street as follows.

Commencing at the South east corner of block No 96 thence running North along the east side of said block, to the North east corner of the said block No 96 being a distance of 640 feet more or less such sidewalk to be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same, at their own expense within thirty (30) days from the time at which this ordinance shall take effect and they be relieved from any assessment that may be made for the construction thereof by the City.

Provided that the work to be done shall in all respects conform to the requirements of the Ordinance relating to Sidewalks passed and adopted November 7th A D 1884

— Section 2 — That if the sidewalk mentioned in section One (1) aforesaid shall not be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same within the time mentioned in said Sec

2 One (1) then such sidewalks shall be constructed by
3 the City under and in pursuance of the provisions
4 of Ordinance No 19 concerning the assessment of
5 special charges upon the owners of lots and lands
6 within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Collins,
7 passed and adopted Sept 15 A.D. 1884 and the
8 expense they collected in the manner provided
9 in said Ordinance.
