

ORDINANCE NO. 101, 2014
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
AMENDING ARTICLE XII OF CHAPTER 23 OF THE CITY CODE
RELATING TO ART IN PUBLIC PLACES

WHEREAS, on April 25, 1995, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 020, 1995, establishing the Art in Public Places (APP) Program, adopting the Art in Public Places Guidelines, and setting goals and requirements for the acquisition, maintenance and exhibition of public art by the City; and

WHEREAS, On April 7, 1998, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 047, 1998, which reenacted the APP Provisions of the City Code with certain modifications; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment would increase the threshold for which City Council approval is required prior to contacting for certain APP projects, increasing it from \$10,000 to \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend Article XII of Chapter 23 of the City Code as provided herein to align the APP purchasing threshold with purchasing exemptions elsewhere in the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS as follows:

Section 1. That Section 23-308 of the Code of the City of Fort Collins is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 23-308. Acquisition of works of art.

The APP Board shall make recommendations to the City Council concerning the use of funds in excess of thirty thousand (\$30,000) for the acquisition, installation and maintenance of works of art. The construction project from which the funds were generated should generally be the site where the funds will be used. However, funds may be expended at other sites when the APP Board determines such expenditure is appropriate based on the considerations set forth in the guidelines. The APP Board may appoint a selection committee to make recommendations to the APP Board concerning the selection of artists, works of art and the placement of works of art. The selection committee may include artists, architects, City representatives and members of the public.

Introduced, considered favorably on first reading, and ordered published this 15th day of July, A.D. 2014, and to be presented for final passage on the 19th day of August, A.D. 2014.
