

ORDINANCE NO. 2, 2000
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
APPROPRIATING UNANTICIPATED REVENUE IN THE GENERAL
FUND FOR THE POLICE SERVICES VICTIM SERVICES TEAM

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$19,000 from the Eighth Judicial District Victims and Law Enforcement (V.A.L.E.) Board to support the City's Police Services Victim Services Team (the "Grant"); and


WHEREAS, the Grant funds will be used to fund a part-time victim advocate and related equipment needed for the Victim Services Team; and

WHEREAS, the Grant requires an in-kind match which is met by volunteer hours and the existing Police Services budget; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 9, of the Charter of the City of Fort Collins permits the City Council to make supplemental appropriations by ordinance at any time during the fiscal year, provided that the total amount of such supplemental appropriations, in combination with all previous appropriations for that fiscal year, do not exceed the then current estimate of actual and anticipated revenues to be received during the fiscal year.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that there is hereby appropriated for expenditure from unanticipated grant revenue in the General Fund the sum of NINETEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$19,000) for expenditure, upon receipt, in the General Fund to fund additional staff for the Victim Services Team.




