

RESOLUTION 77-71
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION OF THE UNITED STATES
DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR FOR THE PURPOSE OF
ACQUIRING A LICENSE FOR INSTALLATION OF A RAW
WATER TRANSMISSION LINE ON PROPERTY OF THE UNITED STATES

WHEREAS the City has heretofore entered into an agreement with the Bureau of Reclamation of the United States Department of the Interior for the enlargement of Soldier Canyon Outlet, and

WHEREAS, said enlargement would provide additional raw water capacity for the City's Water Treatment Plant No 2, and

WHEREAS, additional capacity is required in the transmission line carrying raw water from the Soldier Canyon Outlet to said treatment plant and

WHEREAS in order to obtain such additional capacity, it is necessary that a new fifty-four inch (54") line be installed across property belonging to the Federal Government and


WHEREAS, the City and the Federal Government desire to enter into an agreement whereby the City would acquire an easement from the Federal Government for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating such transmission line and

WHEREAS the City Attorney has reviewed and approved said agreement

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that the terms and conditions of said agreement be, and the same hereby are, accepted and approved and


