

FINDINGS AND RESOLUTION 72-19
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, COLORADO, ACTING
AS THE LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY CONCERNING AN APPLICA-
TION FOR THE RETAIL LIQUOR STORE LICENSE

THE APPLICATION of Arnold Schweitzer and Clyde L. Badger for a retail liquor store license came on for hearing on the 2nd day of March, 1972, in the Council Chambers of City Hall, Fort Collins, Colorado pursuant to Notice duly given as required by law. Said time being the time to which the hearing had been duly continued with the consent of the applicant and other interested parties.

The authority, having heard the evidence introduced at the hearing, examined the evidence presented and having heretofore held a preliminary hearing and issued findings in writing on said preliminary hearing, now makes the following findings:

1. The neighborhood to be served under this application is as defined in the preliminary findings of the authority heretofore adopted.
2. Nothing contained in C.R.S. 1963 Section 75-2-39 prohibits issuing a license at the proposed location.
3. The applicants are of good moral character and qualified under the ordinances of the City of Fort Collins and the laws of the State of Colorado for the license applied for.
4. From the testimony produced at the hearing and the petitions presented, it appears that the licenses already granted in the neighborhood are adequate for the reasonable needs of the neighborhood.
5. From the evidence produced and the petitions presented at the hearing it appears that the inhabitants of the neighborhood do not desire that the license be granted .
