

RESOLUTION 86-116
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
ADOPTING THE JULY 1986 EDITION OF THE CITY OF
FORT COLLINS STREET DESIGN CRITERIA AND
CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

WHEREAS, in September of 1981, the Council of the City of Fort Collins passed Resolution 81-130 which adopted the 1981 Edition of *Design Criteria and Standards for Streets*, to be used by the City as the basis for street design standards, structural design criteria, construction standards and standards concerning curbs, gutters, sidewalks and other appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineering staff and a committee representing contractors, designers and developers has met and developed a 1986 Edition of the aforesaid manual; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fort Collins has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City that the 1986 Edition of *Design Criteria and Standards for Streets* be adopted.


