

RESOLUTION 88- 180  
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE PROPERTY  
LOCATED AT 108 NORTH MELDRUM  
AKA AVERY CARRIAGE HOUSE

WHEREAS, on July 5, 1988, the Council of the City of Fort Collins passed Resolution 88-107 which allocated Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000) in Community Development Block Grant funds for the acquisition of the Avery Carriage House; and

WHEREAS, City staff members and the Poudre Landmarks Foundation have negotiated the purchase price of Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000), and in accordance with Resolution 88-107, the City of Fort Collins would use the allocated Community Development Block Grant funds to purchase this property; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Fort Collins that the City purchase the Avery Carriage House which would be used for educational programs, displays for school children, adult education, and specialized group projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that the City Manager be, and he hereby is, authorized to enter into an agreement for the purchase of property located at 108 North Meldrum, Fort Collins, Colorado, for an amount not to exceed Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000), to be leased to the Poudre Landmarks Foundation.
