



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Rick Price has been instrumental in establishing bicycling advocacy in Fort Collins; and

WHEREAS, he was the driving force behind the founding of Bike Fort Collins. He promoted its initial vision of “more bikes and more bike safety”, a vision that has survived since 2005; and

WHEREAS, he volunteered his time to lead the City's Bicycle Advisory Committee for many years and played a major role in the development of Fort Collins Bicycle Master Plans; and

WHEREAS, Rick Price played a key role in developing the foundation for what is now a Platinum Bicycle Friendly Community and one of the top-rated bicycling cities in the country; and

WHEREAS, he served as a League Cycling Instructor and a voice for bicycle safety education and advocacy through community cycling education and newspaper articles, He also started the Safe Routes to School volunteer instructor training; and

WHEREAS, Rick advocated for the development and funding of a Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Town, which was ultimately built as the Walk & Wheel Skills Hub in 2017. He led the effort to start the Bike Coop and bring bicycle mobility to everyone, including under-served populations; and

WHEREAS, Rick Price deserves to be recognized for the bicycle initiatives he has promoted and the time he has contributed to bicycling in Fort Collins.
