To Whom It May Respectively Concern;

On May 2nd, 2017, I was transferred from D.R.D.C. to Canon City. The new mailing address is as follows: CTCF/CH5, P.O. Box 1010 Canon City, CO 81215-1010. I am being held in the Court Transport Unit, also known as cell house #5. The plaintive does not know when he will be transferred to a permanent facility. The plaintive in good faith filed a AR-Form 750-01A, or request for legal assistance at D.R.D.C. and received no response. The plaintive is now re-filing 750-01A immediately at this Canon City holding facility. The plaintive is also filing a DC Form 750-01E, also known as "Request for Supplies." This request is being filed tonight to request 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" size Manila Envelopes, white envelopes, one packet of paper, and a U.S. District Court caption form. At Larimer County Jail, Scott, the facility's Title III Programmer and Librarian, provided me with a new blank Prisoner's complaint. When I was transferred to D.R.D.C., the facility seized all my paper, and legal envelopes.

The plaintive has completed a large portion of the AMENDED PRISONER COMPLAINT, but has to utilize the available resources. This means the plaintive had to erase prior writing on documents to create blank pages.

The plaintive has been provided no adequate sized blank papers, no access to a law library, no ability to copy the new complaint, no manila envelopes, etc. The plaintive does request special consideration in the Court to copy the new complaint. It will be impossible to both copy and meet the 30 day deadline. The AMENDED PRISONER COMPLAINT will have slight handwriting on the back, and Claim #1 was accidentally used as blank paper, so I had to manually create a new page. The plaintive has extremely limited resources, and would like to convey to the Judge about the undue hardships suffered by the plaintive due to being transferred twice in less than 10 days. I will try to comply with 30 day order as long as the facility will actually mail my complaint. It will be mailed by May 8th, 2017 at the latest.



On April 24th, 2017; I was transferred from Larimer County Jail to Denver Reception & Diagnostic Center located in Denver, CO. The mailing address here is as follows: P.O. Box 392004 Denver, CO 80239. I am pending transfer to a permanent Facility, and do not know what facility or when I'll be transferred. I have two court appearances on May 23rd, and May 24th, and a scheduled jury trial on the week of June 19th → 23rd. During these time periods, I'll be on WRITS back to Larimer County Detention Center (L.C.D.C.)

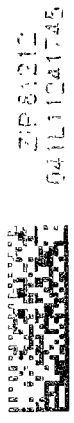
This letter is also meant to convey to Magistrate Judge GORDON P. GALLAGHER the following hardships out of the plaintiff's control. (1) D.R.D.C. seized all my blank legal paper, (2) D.R.D.C. will not allow me access to Law Library, (3) D.R.D.C. will not copy my AMENDED COMPLAINT, (4) D.R.D.C. will not provide a manila envelope to mail documents, and (5) D.R.D.C. has been returning my mail, or not sending mail in a timely manner. I will attempt to the best of my ability to meet 30-day Order, meaning I'll mail an AMENDED COMPLAINT by May 8th, to meet May 12th/13th deadline, but I may have to request an extension, or attempt to mail in two separate envelopes.

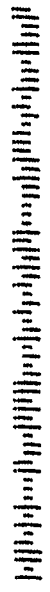
