This matter is before the Court on Defendant's Motion for Extension of Time to File Proposed Scheduling Order and Continue Scheduling Conference (the "Motion"). [#39] In the Motion, Defendant states that he "intends to move to dismiss Plaintiff's claims, assert the doctrine of qualified immunity, and move to stay these proceedings accordingly." [*Id.* at ¶ 7] Defendant thus requests that the Scheduling Conference and attendant deadlines be continued. [*Id.* at ¶ 8] The Court finds that judicial economy and the resources of the parties would best be served by resolving Defendant's forthcoming motion to stay prior to conducting a Scheduling Conference in this matter.

Accordingly, the Motion is **GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART**. The Scheduling Conference set for September 15, 2017 at 10:00 AM is **VACATED** to be reset, if necessary, after resolution of Defendant's forthcoming motion to stay. Defendant shall file any motion to stay on or before **September 20, 2017**, and Defendant shall file his response within **twenty-one days** of the filing of the motion to stay. A Telephonic Status Conference is **SET** for **October 25, 2017 at 10:00 AM**. The parties may participate in the conference by calling the Court at 303.335.2365 at the scheduled time.
