
PRO SE PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO EXTEND

Through this motion, the Plaintiff requests that the deadline to respond to the Defendant's Motions to Dismiss [#28, 39] be extended another 21 days. This creates a deadline of 8/29/2019 for the Plaintiff to respond to motions.
