



## STATEMENT OF INITIATIVE PETITION SUFFICIENCY

I, Delynn Coldiron, City Clerk, do hereby certify that:

1. On November 2, 2020, petition representatives Elena M. Lopez, Melissa Rosas, and Paul Patterson submitted a petition to initiate an ordinance relating to the purchase, zoning, and use of the property known as the Hughes Stadium property; and
2. Said petition requested that the initiated ordinance be placed before the voters at a regular municipal election (April 2021); and
3. An initiative petition seeking consideration at a regular election must be signed by registered electors of the city equal in number to at least ten (10) percent of the total ballots cast in the last regular city election; and
4. The number of signatures of registered voters who live within the Fort Collins city limits required for said petition to be sufficient is 3,280; and
5. Upon examination of the petition, it has been determined that the petition contains more than 3,280 valid signatures, and the petition is therefore sufficient for placement on a regular municipal election ballot; and
6. This determination of sufficiency is subject to protest within ten (10) days of the filing of the petition, which deadline is 5:00 p.m. on November 12, 2020; and if protested, will be superseded by a new determination of sufficiency or insufficiency following hearing on the protest(s) and certification of the results of the hearing.
