WE HEREBY ENTER OUR BID FOR THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS' REQUIREMENTS FOR TREE BRANCH GRINDING PER THE BID INVITATION AND ANY REFERENCED SPECIFICATIONS:

The City of Fort Collins is requesting bids for tree branch grinding located at the City wood lot, located at 1380 Hoffman Mill Road; and also at the Streets facility, located at Lemay Avenue and Vine Street.

Grinding will take place on site, and ground twice to be consistent with the product that the City Forestry department produces per scope of work.

All work must be completed by June 30, 2017 or sooner.

The contractor who has the lowest lump sum bid will be awarded the work. If the work is not completed on time and to the consistency approved by the City, the City reserves the right to call in another grinding company and the awarded contractor must pay to have it completed.

**Bid Schedule**

Contractor agrees that they will grind the tree branches twice and to the required consistency. All mobilization, equipment, labor and fuel is included in your lump sum bid for a turnkey job.

### Scope of Work

- Bids shall include mobilization fees
- Contractors shall provide their staffing, equipment hourly costs and grinding capabilities
- Bid is to include converting all material (brush and logs) on the site into mulch
- If large diameter material cannot be converted to mulch it must be disposed of at the vendors expense
- Grinding is to occur over consecutive days
- Contractors will have five working days to complete the project
- Contractors will be responsible for coordinating dust suppression control measures with the forestry division
- All material must be processed twice in order to produce a landscape quality product
- Material shall be processed using smaller screens throughout the second grinding of material to provide a high quality product
- Scheduling shall be coordinated through the forestry division

\* Due to storm collection material, both sites may exceed 5 days
