**Specifications:**

Attached are the pictures of the Club Tico chairs. There are two different sizes, as depicted in the pictures. There are 25 Baltic Birch wooden contoured chairs with chrome legs. They came from CSU and, apparently, are copies of a Charles Eames design. Back and seat of molded plywood shaped in compound curves. Curved chrome metal bar connects back and seat, attached with rubber shock mounts. Attached to this bar are u-shaped metal bars for front and back legs, the front being slightly longer. Feet have applied rubber and chrome pads.
