

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned Naranjo Civil Constructors, Inc. as Principal, and Westfield Insurance Company as Surety, are hereby held and firmly bound unto the City of Fort Collins, Colorado, as Owner, in the penal sum of Five Percent of Amount Bid (\$5%) for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves, successors, and assigns.

THE CONDITION of this obligation is such that whereas the Principal has submitted to the City of Fort Collins, Colorado the accompanying bid and hereby made a part hereof to enter into a Contract Agreement for the construction of City of Fort Collins Project, Bid No. 5963 - Trail Work 2006




