**GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1**

A meeting of the General Improvement District No. 1 was held on Tuesday, November 5, 2013, at 10:35 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City of Fort Collins City Hall. Roll Call was answered by the following Boardmembers: Campana, Cunniff, Horak, Overbeck, Poppaw, and Troxell.

**Ordinance No. 065,  
Determining and Fixing the Mill Levy for the General Improvement District No. 1  
for the Fiscal Year 2014; Directing the Secretary of the District to Certify Such  
Levy to the Board of Commissioners of Larimer County; and Making the Fiscal  
Year 2014 Annual Appropriation, Adopted on Second Reading**

The following is the staff memorandum for this item.

***“EXECUTIVE SUMMARY***

*This Ordinance, unanimously adopted on First Reading on October 15, 2013, sets the mill levy for General Improvement District No. 1 at 4.924 mills for fiscal year 2014. The sum of \$276,258 is anticipated to be collected from the mill levy. Additional revenue for GID No. 1 from sources like automobile specific ownership taxes, ad valorem taxes, and interest earnings are anticipated to total \$37,732. The total 2014 revenue for GID No. 1 is expected to be \$313,990.”*

Eric Sutherland, 3520 Golden Currant, asked if this Board ever certified to the Larimer County Assessor, by August 1, 2013, that it wished any more than 50% of its property taxes to be diverted to the Downtown Development Authority.

Boardmember Cunniff requested information regarding Mr. Sutherland's comments. City Attorney Roy replied the property tax administrator looked at the question of whether the City has properly certified the issue. He stated his recollection is that there was a GID No. 1 Board of Directors certification and he will check on the issue.

Boardmember Cunniff requested that appropriate certifications occur at least on the Consent Calendar.


Boardmember Troxell made a motion, seconded by Boardmember Poppaw, to adopt Ordinance No. 065, on Second Reading. Yeas: Troxell, Poppaw, Horak, Campana, Overbeck and Cunniff. Nays: none.
