First Reading of Ordinance No. 014, Determining and Fixing the Mill Levy for the Skyview South General Improvement District No. 15 for the Fiscal Year 2021; Directing the Secretary of the District to Certify Such Levy to the Board of Commissioners of Larimer County; and Making the Fiscal Year 2021 Annual Appropriation. (Adopted on First Reading)


This Ordinance includes the annual appropriation for 2021 of \$1,000 for the expenses of the Skyview South General Improvement District No. 15 (GID No. 15). The sum of \$32,930 is anticipated to be collected from the mill levy of 10.0 mills for fiscal year 2021. Additional miscellaneous revenue for GID No. 15 of \$1,713 is anticipated to be generated from interest income. The total 2021 revenue for GID No. 15 is expected to be \$34,643. The total amount will be used in the future to maintain and repair roads in the Skyview subdivision.

Lawrence Pollack, Budget Director, stated the Skyview District GID revenues are pooled each year until there is enough to do a street project; however, no projects are planned for this year and this appropriation is just for the filing fees for Larimer County for the GID.
