2. **Second Reading of Ordinance No. 014 Determining and Fixing the Mill Levy for the Skyview South General Improvement District No. 15 for the Fiscal Year 2021; Directing the Secretary of the District to Certify Such Levy to the Board of Commissioners of Larimer County; and Making the Fiscal Year 2021 Annual Appropriation. (Adopted on Second Reading)**


This Ordinance, unanimously adopted on First Reading on November 4, 2020, includes the annual appropriation for 2021 of \$1,000 for the expenses of the Skyview South General Improvement District No. 15 (GID No. 15). The sum of \$32,930 is anticipated to be collected from the mill levy of 10.0 mills for fiscal year 2021. Additional miscellaneous revenue for GID No. 15 of \$1,713 is anticipated to be generated from interest income. The total 2021 revenue for GID No. 15 is expected to be \$34,643. The total amount will be used in the future to maintain and repair roads in the Skyview subdivision.

Vice Chair Stephens made a motion, seconded by Boardmember Gutowsky, to adopt Ordinance No. 014, on Second Reading.
