Dear Mr. Kull:

Per our on site meeting at the Rams Bookstore on October 30, 1984, the following are the recommendations related to saving the two (2) large existing Blue Spruce on the corner.

The two spruce are quite large and are a significant landscape element on the site. They are quite visible being located on the corner and are worth saving if possible.

The proposed addition to the building would require the removal of both trees. Because of the significance of the trees, I recommend that you also consider a smaller expansion of the building where one or both of the trees could be saved.

If a smaller addition does not appear feasible and the trees would have to be removed, replacement plantings on the adjacent public right-of-way along Mason should be made. Four shade trees of an approved species that are at the minimum size of 1 3/4" caliper or greater could be planted along that section of Mason. We would be glad to help you in selecting the species and the actual planting locations.
