

ORDINANCE NO 1 1936  
BEING AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF 6%  
REGISTERED WARRANTS NOT TO EXCEED THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$6500 00  
TO PURCHASE A BITUMINOUS MATERIAL DISTRIBUTOR FROM MUNICIPAL  
SUPPLY COMPANY

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the annual appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1936, an emergency and unforeseen contingency has arisen, whereby it has become and is necessary to expend not to exceed the sum of Sixty-five Hundred (\$6500 00) Dollars on account of the cost of acquiring a bituminous material distributor from Municipal Supply Company of South Bend Indiana, the same to be used in connection with the street oiling projects, being Consolidated Improvement Districts Nos 40 and 41, so that funds granted through the United States under the P W A may be available for the said improvement work

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS

Section 1 That there be and hereby is appropriated out of the general revenues of the City of Fort Collins for the year 1936 and subsequent years or from such other source or sources as may hereafter be directed by the City Council unless taken up prior thereto the sum of Sixty-five Hundred (\$6500 00) Dollars on account of expense of acquiring a bituminous material distributor from Municipal Supply Company of South Bend Indiana and registered 6% warrants of the City, shall be issued to cover the amount required therefor, not to exceed the sum of Sixty-five Hundred (\$6500 00) Dollars, the denomination of said warrants to be as directed by the Commissioner of Finance, which said

sum, when this ordinance shall take effect shall be credited on the books of the City Clerk and City Treasurer respectively to Special Oiling Equipment Fund

Section 2 In the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health peace and safety and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage under and by virtue of the authority contained in Sections 6 and 7 of Article IV of the City Charter
