

ORDINANCE NO. 35, 1923

BEING AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10, SERIES OF 1919, RELATING TO WATER WORKS, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 32.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 10, 1919, being an emergency ordinance relating to water works be amended by adding thereto a new section to be known as Section 32, as follows:


"Section 32. That any and all delinquent payments for water rent or other services which will accrue on the property and premises upon which water service has been rendered, and other services in connection therewith or any purpose whatever connected with the service of water, notwithstanding the disconnection of service for failure to make payment, the amount due and in default shall in addition to said right of enforcement by disconnection of service, become a lien on the property and premises so served, to the amount of water rent due, and other services, from the date the same accrued and became due and payable, and said delinquent payments enforced by assessment upon the property and premises so served, and certification thereof to the County Treasurer for collection under and in pursuance of the authority and procedure provided in Ordinance No. 19, 1884, concerning assessment and collection of special charges."

Section 2. In the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, under and by virtue of the authority contained in Sections 6 and 7 of Article IV of the City Charter.

Introduced, read at length and adopted by the unanimous vote of all the members of the City Council this 24th day of November, A. D. 1923.
