

ORDINANCE NO 9, 1923  
BEING AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE RELATING TO ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1923

Whereas, It appears from the report of the Auditor for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1922, that additional miscellaneous receipts are anticipated to the amount of \$5,624 38 and that require emergency appropriations to be made for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1923 to cover the same out of the general revenues for said year, and further, it appears from the report of the Commissioner of Works that an additional appropriation of \$12,000 00 is required to meet the requirements of permanent improvements in the waterworks system by the extension of mains therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS

Section 1 That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
out  
following sum<sup>s</sup>/of the general revenues for the fiscal year ending  
December 31, 1923 for the purposes herein stated, to wit

Preliminary local improvement expense	\$5,000 00
Streets and alleys	525 00
General Government,	99 38
For waterworks improvement, out of the waterworks revenue,	12,000 00


Section 2 By reason of the fact that the aporopriations for Public Works General Government and Water Department for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1923 is insufficient to meed the demands and requirements of the Public Works General Government and Water Department, it is imperative that this supplemental appropriation to provide for this necessity for the present fiscal year shall be effective at once and it is hereby declared that an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety and therefore pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 6 and 7 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full

force upon its passage, adoption and publication in the official newspaper under the provisions of Section 7 of Article IV of the City Charter
