


ORDINANCE NO. 34, 1922,
BEING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING THE ANNUAL
APPROPRIATION MADE FOR STREETS AND ALLEYS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
DECEMBER 31, 1922.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS:


Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated out of the revenues of the City of Fort Collins for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1922 and ending December 31, 1922, in addition to the annual appropriation heretofore made for streets and alleys for said fiscal period, the sum of Thirteen hundred eighty-four and 13/100 (\$1384.13) Dollars, which said sum is supplemental to the appropriation heretofore made for streets and alleys for said fiscal period.

Section 2. By reason of the fact that the appropriation for streets and alleys for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1922, is insufficient to meet the demands and requirements of the Public Works Department of the city government, it is imperative that this supplemental appropriation to provide for the needs of the Public Works Department for the present fiscal year shall be made effective at once, and it is hereby declared that an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety; and therefore, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 6 of Article IV of the City Charter, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, adoption and publication in the official newspaper under the provisions of Section 7 of Article IV of the City Charter.

Introduced, read and adopted by the vote of all the members of the City Council this 23rd day of December, A. D. 1922.
