

ORDINANCE NO. 27, 1922

BEING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1923 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1923, AND FIXING THE MILL LEVIES FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the City of Fort Collins for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1923, and ending December 31, 1923, the sum of Two Hundred Four Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-four and 67/100 (\$204, 334.67) Dollars, to be raised by taxation and otherwise, which said sum is hereby divided and appropriated for the following purposes, towit:



The balance, if any, of revenue from water rentals shall be applied toward paying interest bearing warrants that may be outstanding on account of any water works improvements, and any balance remaining shall be applied toward the redemption of the Second Series \$75,000.00 issue of Water Bonds of said City

Section 2. That for the purpose of providing the necessary funds for meeting the appropriations set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance, the following levy is hereby made upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Collins, the same being the amount necessary to provide for the payment of the foregoing appropriations and to meet the payment thereof during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1923, of all properly authorized demands upon the City Treasurer for general expense 11 34 mills, which levy shall be certified to the Board of County Commissioners of Larimer County, by the Commissioner of Safety and Ex Officio Mayor and the City Clerk, as provided by law.
