

ORDINANCE NO 25, 1922

RELATING TO THE CREATION OF A PUBLIC ALLEY IN MORGER-SMITH SUBDIVISION TO THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF THE SAID ALLEY FOR PUBLIC USE

WHEREAS, The City of Fort Collins has acquired title to the following parcel of land situate in the Morger-Smith Subdivision for the purpose of creating a public alley and ordering the same open to public use, towit Beginning on the west property line of Mack Street 190 feet North of the North property line of Mountain Avenue, thence west 415 feet, thence north 20 feet, thence east 415 feet, thence south 20 feet to the point of beginning, therefore


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS


Section 1 That a strip of land described as follows Beginning on the west property line of Mack Street 190 feet North of the North property line of Mountain Avenue, thence west 415 feet, thence north 20 feet, thence east 415 feet, thence south 20 feet to the point of beginning, situated in the Morger-Smith Subdivision of the City of Fort Collins, be and hereby is declared to constitute a public alley for the use of the general public

Section 2 That upon the taking effect of this ordinance the Commissioner of Public Works be and he is hereby authorized and directed to cause said strip of land described in Section 1 of this ordinance, to be opened as an alley for public use and to cause the same to be put in good travel condition for said purpose.
