

ORDINANCE NO. 14, 1922,
BEING AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 1 OF AMENDATORY ORDINANCE NO. 3, 1918, RELATING
TO THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS:


Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3, 1918, being amendatory ordinance of Ordinance No. 11 of 1913, relating to the time and place of meeting of the City Council, be amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 1. The regular meeting of the City Council shall be held at the City Hall on Saturday of each week at eight o'clock, A. M. Special meetings of the City Council may be called by any two members thereof, provided the call of such special meeting and the subjects to be considered at said special meeting shall be in writing and signed by two members of the City Council and filed with the City Clerk. Thereupon the City Clerk shall immediately give notice in writing to all members of the City Council of the time of said special meeting and the subjects which are to be considered at said special meeting."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 3. In the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, under and by virtue of the authority contained in Sections 6 and 7 of Article IV of the City Charter.
