

ORDINANCE NO 7 1917

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO 10, 1901, RELATING TO FIRE LIMITS AND BUILDING INSPECTION, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO 15 1906 AND AS FURTHER AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO 3 1912 AND FURTHER AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO 9 1913, PASSED AND ADOPTED ON THE 15TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1913

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS


Section 1 That Section 1 of Ordinance No 10 of the Series of 1901 as amended by Ordinance No 15 1906 and as further amended by Ordinance No 3, 1912 and further amended by Ordinance No 9 1913, passed and adopted on the 15th day of September 1913 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows

Section 1 All that portion of the City of Fort Collins embraced within the following described limits shall hereafter be known as the Fire Limits of the City of Fort Collins Commencing at a point at the intersection of Cherry Street and Mason Street in said city thence south along the center of Mason Street to the center of Mountain Avenue, thence west along the center of Mountain Avenue to the center of Howe's Street thence south along the center of Howe's Street to the center of Olive Street thence east along the center of Olive Street to the center of Peterson Street thence north along the center of Peterson Street to the center of Mountain Avenue thence northeasterly to the center of Jefferson Street thence northwesterly along the center of Jefferson Street to the center of College Avenue thence north on College Avenue to the center of the intersection of Cherry Street with College Avenue thence west along the center line of Cherry Street to the place of beginning, being the center of the intersection of Cherry and Mason Streets No building of any kind shall be erected within said limits unless permission

to construct the same is obtained and the same is constructed pursuant to ordinances now in force in said city or the ordinances hereafter to be passed and adopted by said City Council of said city relating to building and building inspection



I Ray Baxter City Clerk of the City of Fort Collins do hereby certify and declare that the foregoing ordinance, consisting of one (1) section duly proposed and read at length at a meeting of the City Council held on the 12th day of February, A D 1917 was duly ordered by Aye and Nay vote to be published in the Fort Collins Courier, a daily newspaper of the City of Fort Collins in accordance with the provisions of Section 7 of Article IV of the City Charter, that thereafter and on to-wit the 21th day of February A D 1917, at a regular meeting of the City Council said ordinance came before said Council on its final passage a period of more than ten days having elapsed since the publication as set forth and that said ordinance was upon second reading adopted as an ordinance, and thereafter and on to-wit, the 27th day of February 1917, said Ordinance No 7 1917, as finally passed and adopted was duly published in the Fort Collins Courier, a daily newspaper published in the City of Fort Collins Colorado
