Ordinance No. 1 1904.

Relating to the Annual appropriation for the Fiscal year, beginning April 1st, 1904, and terminating March 31st, 1905.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins, Colorado. Section I. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the fiscal year beginning April 1st, 1904, and terminating March 31st, 1905, the sum of

Twenty three thousand four hundred eighty one (23,481) dollars to be raised by taxation and otherwise, which said sum is hereby divided and appropriated to the following specific purposes, to wit:
