

Relating to Excavations.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, Company or Corporation to make any excavations in the earth upon any lot or block in the City of Fort Collins by boring, drilling or digging in the earth for the purpose of and with the intention of discovering oil, gas, coal or minerals of any kind; or to erect any derricks, scaffolding or other device used in or about the boring or drilling of wells within the city of Fort Collins, without first having obtained a permit from the City Council of the City of Fort Collins so to do, and the written consent thereto of all of the owners of the property abutting or adjoining the tract or tracts of land upon which any of the said operations may be proposed.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, Company or Corporation to make any excavation in the City of Fort Collins for the purpose of obtaining earth to manufacture into brick, or to establish any brick yard in the City of Fort Collins, without first having obtained a permit from the City Council of the City of Fort Collins so to do, and the written consent ^{all of} of the owners of property adjoining the lots or blocks upon which is proposed to make such excavations or establish such brick yards.

Section 3. Any person, Company or Corporation failing to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance or any part thereof shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than \$300 and costs of suit.
