

Ordinance No *9*-1899

A petition having been presented to the City Council for the construction of a stone sidewalk on the south side of Magnolia street, between Mathew and ~~Peterson~~ ^{Reynolds} streets, and signed by a majority of the owners of frontage upon said street between the points above mentioned. Therefore

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins

Section 1, That a stone sidewalk shall be ~~tax~~ constructed on Magnolia street as follows - Commencing at a point opposite the north east corner of block No 144, at the intersection of said Magnolia and Peterson streets, thence running west and on the south side of said Magnolia street to a point opposite the northwest corner of said block No 13, at the intersection of said Magnolia and ~~Reynolds~~ ^{Reynolds} streets such sidewalk to be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same at their own expense within thirty (30) days from the time at which this ordinance shall take effect, and there by be relieved from any assessments that may be made for the construction thereof by the City, provided that the work so to be done shall in all respects conform to the requirements of the ordinance relating to sidewalks passed and adopted November 17th 1884

Section 2, That if the sidewalk mentioned in section one (1) of this ordinance shall not be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same within the time mentioned in said section one (1), then such sidewalk shall be constructed by the City under and in persuance of the provisions of ordinance No 19, 1884 concerning the assessments of special charges upon the owners of lots or lands within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Collins, passed and adopted September 15th 1884, and the expense thereof collected in the manner provided for in said ordinance
