

A petition having been presented to the City Council for the construction of a stone sidewalk on the <sup>west</sup> ~~east~~ side of Remington street between Mulberry and Laurel streets, and signed by a majority of the owners of frontage upon said street between the points above named

Therefore -

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins

Section 1- That a <sup>shall</sup> stone sidewalk, be constructed on Remington street as follows - Commencing at a point opposite the northeast corner of block No 125, at the intersection of said Remington and Mulberry streets thence running south and on the west side of said Remington street to ~~the~~ a point opposite the southwest corner of block No 126, at the intersection of said Remington and Laurel streets

Said sidewalk to be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same at their own expense within thirty (30) days from the time at which this ordinance shall take effect, and there by be relieved from any assessments that may be made for the construction thereof by the City, provided that the work so to be done ~~shall~~ shall in all respects conform to the requirements of <sup>the</sup> ordinance relating to sidewalks passed and adopted November 17th 1834

Section 2- That if the sidewalk mentioned in section one (1) of this ordinance shall not be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same within the time mentioned in said section one (1), then <sup>such</sup> ~~said~~ sidewalk shall be constructed by the City under and in pursuance of the provisions of ordinance No 19, 1834 concerning the assessments of special charges upon the owners of lots or lands within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Collins, passed and ~~and~~ adopted September 15th 1834, and the expense thereof collected in the manner provided in said ordinance
