ORDINANCE No. 8 1898.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS,

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, within the city limits, <sup>when</sup> using water from the city water works, upon lawns, gardens, or orchards, to use, operate, permit, or cause to be used, or operated, at one and the same time, more than one nozzle, sprinkler, or other apparatus upon his or her premises without first having secured the right to do so, from the city council.

~~Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, <sup>when</sup> using water from the city water works within the city limits, upon lawns, gardens, or orchards, to use, operate, permit, or cause to be used or operated, a nozzle, sprinkler, or other apparatus with an aperture through which the water flows, greater than three sixteenths of one inch in diameter.~~

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum of not less than five dollars, and not more than ten dollars, or imprisoned in the county jail not less than five days, nor more than thirty days.
