

Ordinance No 6 1898.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Fort Collins

Sec 1st That it shall be the duty of the City Attorney to attend all meetings of the City Council to advise the City Council upon any matters of law when requested to do so, and, when required by a majority of the council, he shall submit his opinion ~~of~~ questions of law referred to him, in writing, he shall draft all ordinances to be enacted by the council, draw and prepare all bonds, contracts, deeds and other instruments in writing to be executed by the City Council, to institute and prosecute all actions brought before the city magistrate for the violation of any of the city ordinances, and to attend to and perform such other business as may be required of him as such city attorney-

Sec 2^d The the City Attorney shall receive as his compensation the sum of one hundred dollars per annum, to be paid in quarterly payments

Sec 3^d All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed-
