

Relating to sidewalks on La Porte Avenue between College Avenue and Mason Street

Be it Ordained by the City Council, of the City of Fort Collins, Section I That an ~~12-foot~~ <sup>12 feet wide</sup> sidewalk shall be constructed <sup>the south side</sup> on La Porte Avenue as follows Commencing at the northeast corner of block No twenty one (21), where said La Porte Avenue intersects with College Avenue, thence running west and in front of the block on the south side of said La Porte Avenue to the north west corner of said block No twenty one (21), where said La Porte Avenue intersects with Mason Street, ~~thence~~ <sup>And a 8 foot sidewalk 8 feet wide</sup> commencing at the ~~south~~ <sup>south</sup> east corner of block No twenty two (22) where said La Porte Avenue intersects with College Avenue, thence running west and in front of the block and on the north side of said La Porte Avenue to the southwest corner of said block No twenty two (22), where said La Porte Avenue intersects with Mason Street

Said sidewalk to be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same at their own expense within thirty (30) days from the time at which this ordinance shall take effect, and thereby be relieved from any assessments that may be made for the construction thereof by the City, provided that the work so to be done shall in all respects conform to the requirements of the ordinance relating to sidewalks passed and adopted November 17th 1884

Sec 2 That if the sidewalk mentioned in section one (1) of this ordinance shall not be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same within the time mentioned in said section one (1), then said sidewalk shall be constructed by the City under and in pursuance of the provisions of ordinance No 19, 1884 concerning the assessments of special charges upon the owners of lots or lands within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Collins, passed and adopted September 15th 1884, and the expense thereof collected in the manner provided in said ordinance
