

Ordinance No. 9-1896

Relating to Sidewalk on Mulberry Street.  
Whereas a petition having been presented to the city council for the construction of a Stone Sidewalk on Mulberry street and signed by a majority of the owners of frontage on said street.

Whereas the construction of said sidewalk has been declared a necessity by resolution duly passed and adopted by a majority of the city council, therefore Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Fort Collins

Sec 1 That <sup>a</sup>stone sidewalk shall be constructed on Mulberry street in the city of Fort Collins as follows:

Commencing on the North side of said Mulberry street at the Southeast corner of ~~said~~ Block 144 thence running West along said block to the South West corner of Block 144 being a distance of 500 more or less. Such sidewalk to be constructed by the owners of the lots or land abutting on the same at their expense within thirty (30) days from the time this ordinance shall take effect and thereby be relieved from any assessment that may be made for the construction

Sec 2 That if the sidewalk mentioned in Sec. 1 aforesaid shall not be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting on same within the time mentioned in Sec 1 then such sidewalk shall be constructed by the city under and in pursuance of the provisions of Ordinance No. 19 concerning the assessment of special charges upon the owners of lots or lands within the corporate limits of the city of Fort Collins passed and adopted Sept. 15. 1884 and the expense thereof collected in the manner provided in said ordinance.
