

Ordinance No 1 1896

A petition having been presented to the City Council for the construction of a Stone Sidewalk on the East side of Matthews Street between Myrtle and Laurel Streets and signed by a majority of the owners of frontage upon said street therefore

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins

Section 1 — That a stone sidewalk shall be constructed on Matthews Street as follows, commencing at the North west corner of Block 146 thence running South a distance of 637 feet to the South west corner of said Block 146 such sidewalk to be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same at their own expense within thirty (30) days from the time at which this Ordinance shall take effect and they be relieved from any assessment that may be made for the construction thereof by the City, provided that the work so to be done shall in all respects conform to the requirements of the Ordinance relating to Sidewalks passed and adopted November 17<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1894

Section 2 — That if the sidewalk mentioned in Section 1 aforesaid shall not be constructed by the owners of the lots or lands abutting upon the same within the time mentioned in said Section One (1) then such sidewalk shall be constructed by the City under and in pursuance of the provisions of Ordinance No 19 Concerning the assessment of Abatement Charges upon the owners

of lots or lands within the corporate limits of the  
City of Fort Collins, passed and adopted -  
September 15 A D 1884 and the expense  
thereof collected in the manner provided in  
said Ordinance, \_\_\_\_\_
