

Ordinance No 12 1895.

Relating to the Sale and Perpetual Care of lots in Grand View Cemetery

Be it Ordained by the city Council of the city of Fort Collins:

Sec. 1 That hereafter every purchaser of a lot in Sections C and E in Grand View Cemetery, shall be required, in addition to the payment of the price fixed for the lot, to pay ^{to the city Clerk} the sum of ~~Twenty~~ (30) dollars, and in consideration therefor, the city of Fort Collins, shall grade and to lawn grass, and take perpetual care of the lot so sold

Sec 2 Every owner of lots as well as all purchasers of lots in other sections of said Grand View Cemetery, shall have the privilege ~~of paying~~ for perpetual care of lot upon the same terms and conditions ^{as} provided in section one of this ordinance,

Sec 3 It shall be the duty of the Mayor and city Clerk in all cases where payment is made for perpetual care of lots, to issue a receipt and certificate therefor to the purchaser under the corporate seal of the city to the effect that in consideration of the payment made, the city of Fort Collins, assume and agrees to take perpetual care of the lot therein described,

The city Clerk shall prepare and cause to be printed in book form ~~said~~ said certificates which shall have an appropriate stubs and be consecutively numbered, in addition thereto a book shall be provided in which shall ^{be} kept a complete record in detail of all certificates ^{issued} under the provisions of this ordinance,

Sec 4 It shall be the duty of the city Clerk and city Treasurer to keep a separate account of all monies received on account of the issuance of certificates pursuant to the provisions of this ordinance and the fund so created shall be known and designated as the "Perpetual Care Fund Grand View Cemetery", which said fund shall be invested or appropriated as may be determined by the city Council,
