

ORDINANCE No. 20-1889
Relating
TO THE PROHIBITION TO FAST DRIVING.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Fort Collins:

SECTION 1. Any person who shall immoderately ride or drive any horse or mule in any street, avenue or alley within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Collins shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction ^{thereof} shall be fined in any sum not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars and costs of suit.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons fined under the provisions of this ordinance, who shall not pay such fine and costs assessed, shall be confined in the City ^{JAIL} ~~day~~ or county jail, or other place of confinement for prisoners, one day for each two dollars of such fine and costs; or such person may be required to work on the streets or public grounds of the City of Fort Collins, one day for each two dollars of such fine and costs, until the same is fully paid.
