

RESOLUTION 84-193  
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO  
A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH  
CITYSCAPE URBAN DESIGN, INC. FOR  
PREPARATION OF A MASTER PLAN FOR  
THE LAUREL SCHOOL NEIGHBORHOOD

WHEREAS, as the development and growth of Fort Collins proceeds, the preservation of viable residential areas in combination with economic growth is essential to maintaining the quality of life; and

WHEREAS, to meet this goal it is imperative that integrated master plans be developed for the historical and residential neighborhoods surrounding downtown Fort Collins; and


WHEREAS, City Council approved an expenditure of Community Development Block Grant funds for a Master Plan for the Laurel School Neighborhood on June 7, 1983, in Resolution 83-102; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Capital Project Management Control System guidelines, Cityscape Urban Design, Inc., presented a proposal for said Master Plan for Laurel School Neighborhood for the total sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000); and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-66 of the Code of the City of Fort Collins, no professional Services Agreement in excess of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) shall be entered into until approved by the City Council in an open Council meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, that the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into a professional services agreement with Cityscape Urban Design, Inc., for a Master Plan for Laurel School Neighborhood, said services to be performed by Cityscape Urban Design, Inc., for a sum not to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000).
